Mark Your Calendars for Our Summer Book Sale

The Adams County Friends of the Library will be holding their 18th annual Summer Book Sale from Wednesday August 1st through Saturday August 4th at Redding Auction House, 1085 Table Rock Road, Gettysburg, PA. This is a new, and somewhat smaller venue for us, but will be air-conditioned and has ample and uncontested free parking. Our hours will be Wednesday August 1st, 12 PM to 8 PM, Thursday and Friday, August 2nd & 3rd from 9AM to 8 PM, and Saturday, August 4th, from 9 AM to 3 PM.

Driving directions are as follows: proceed either north or south on Table Rock Road to the auction house. You can also get to it from either Biglerville Road to Goldenville Road or Old Harrisburg Road to Goldenville Road and then south on Table Rock Road.

Our prices remain unchanged, with hardback books \$2.00 each, large paperbacks \$1.50 and small paperbacks \$.50. We will have a large selection of children's and young adult hardback books at \$1.00 each and children's and young adult paperbacks at \$.50 each. We will also have CD's, DVD's, and some vinyl record albums. We will offer our usual wide selection of book categories as we have in past years. Saturday, August 4th will be our bag of books day. "Bag of books day" are \$6.00 each: buy three and get a fourth bag free. Please note our extended hours that day for your shopping convenience.

Children under 12 years of age are entitled to 5 free books on August 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} . Teachers are also allowed a free bag of books on August 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} for use in their classroom instruction.

Over 2,000 people attended the Third Annual FunFest, a free event for the entire family that launched **Summer Quest**, formerly known as the Summer Reading Program. On June 8th the Gettysburg Rec Park was the place to be for free activities including the *Super Sensational Storytime Show* with Mr. George, face painting, balloon artists, hot dogs grilled by the Kiwanis Club Gettysburg Adams, ice cream by *Antietam Dairy*, treats from Mr. Y's Shaved Ice, tunes from DJ John of Ziegler's Mobile Entertainment, and booths of activities from 41 Adams County organizations.

The Friends of the Adams County Library booth was one of the most popular. Hundreds of children



received a free book! Giving books to families was the perfect activity for FunFest because it supports early childhood literacy efforts and emphasizes the importance of reading early and often to children, as well as engaging them in conversation and other activities around books. Thank you, Friends!

Nearly 100 people registered for Summer Quest at FunFest! There is still time to register at each of the six libraries or on line at <u>www.AdamsLibrary.org</u>. And Summer Quest is for the "big kids" too. Stop by any Adams County Library location to pick up an Adult Summer Reading packet. Here's how to play: for

every book read, fill out a ticket, and turn it into any Adams County Library location to enter for a chance to win a Grand Prize basket. The more books read, the more chances to win the basket, which includes books, candies, Adams County Library System items, tickets to the Seminary Ridge Museum and private Cupola tour, and more.

This summer hundreds of events will take place at our six libraries. Consider bringing your children and grandchildren to a storytime, craft program, or a special music program with Mark DeRose. Hear storyteller Beth Rebert, learn about animals during *Creatures Great and Small*, or attend a STEMobile program offered by the Girl Scouts in the Heart of Pennsylvania.



And if you want to continue your Quest outdoors, join with us for the GO (Get Outdoors) Adams program, in which participants explore Adams County by finding fifteen posts placed in local parks and other locations, and making rubbings of the symbols on the posts. Rubbing sheets can be returned for chances to win prizes. Information for these programs can be found in each library, as well as online at <u>www.AdamsLibrary.org</u>.

As you can see, FunFest is simply the start of our favorite time of year, Summer Quest. I hope to see you soon, and **thank you for helping us to connect people to opportunities that enrich their lives**.
