#### **Early Literacy Extras:**

**Read:** Watch Miss Crystal read *Lucy's Light* by Jo Rooks on our Youth Services Facebook page.

**Talk:** Talk about how it is important to use the strengths that we have been given rather than try to do things that we think are important. What are some things that you can do? How can you use them to help others?

Sing: Rhymes To Do At Home

**Play:** Using the fireflies on the next page or by making your own, scatter fireflies throughout a room, grab a jar, and hunt down some fireflies.

**Write:** Practice using the scissors. Have your child cut out the fireflies on the next page for your firefly hunt.
