Early Literacy Extras:

Parents and caregivers are a child's first and best teachers. Here are some ideas and activities to try this week with your child.

These five practices are designed to help your child develop literacy skills, engage your child, and enhance the bonds between you.

Storytimes at the Adams County Library support Pennsylvania Early Learning Standards.

This week's theme was: **Community Helpers**

Read: Watch Miss Crystal read *Whose Hands* are *These?* by Miranda Paul on our Youth Services Facebook page.

Talk: Talk about who in your community is a helper. What do they do to help people? Is there a way you can be a community helper?

Sing: Rhymes To Do At Home

Play: Play a game of "I Spy" next time you run errands and point out the community helpers that you see. Also point out the things that the person needs, like the firetruck for firefighters, mail bag for postal workers, etc.

Write: Write a thank you letter to a community helper. There are lots of people working very hard including nurses, teachers, and others. Let you child choose someone and help them write a thank you letter.
