## This week's theme was: **Differences** & Inclusion

**Read:** Watch Miss Crystal read *One of These Is Not like the Others* by Barney Saltzberg on our Youth Services Facebook page or YouTube Channel.

**Talk:** Talk to your child about reaching out to others. Talk about how fun it is to spend time with lots of different people and how nice it is to include new friends.

Sing: Rhymes to do at Home

**Play:** Have fun learning how to say "Hello" in some other languages and cooking and eating foods from another culture or country.

**Write:** Help your child cut out some paper people out of different shades of brown and tan paper. Decorate the people with paper clothes, draw faces on each one, use different colored yarn for hair, and see how many different people you can make!
