An update on the Library!

Although the Library is still closed, the staff is still hard at work behind the scenes continuing and creating new services that can be delivered via our virtual branch.

Mr. George is leading and supporting other staff members in providing services to the youth of Adams County. Watch our wonderful storytellers as they educate and entertain from the Gettysburg, Carroll Valley, Littlestown, New Oxford, Harbaugh-Thomas and East Berlin Libraries!

Jess L. is forging ahead with the switch to virtual programming for adults and is working to process many library card applications. Since mid-March, 197 applications had been received and fulfilled by Jess and Sherrie!

Behind the scenes, Sara is keeping our webpage updated and ordering new ebooks every Friday. Use of elibrary resources is increasing every week, due in part to those new library card holders. This week, we have new shelves for children and adults!

Annette is uploading records for our new ebooks and eaudiobooks so that you can find them easily. She's also directing the effort to check the records in our catalog for accuracy so that we'll all be able to find the items in the collections.

Jeff and Dawn are looking for resource opportunities so that we can absorb the unbudgeted costs that the pandemic has brought. Due to publishers' pricing models, the purchase of ebooks and eaudiobooks is more expensive for libraries than for the general public and can cost two or three times as much as their physical counterparts. We are also ordering supplies that will keep us all safe once we are able to return to our buildings.

So as you can see, Brandt and I are relying on all of the library staff to continue to provide services in a new way as we steer our way through uncharted territories. We are working toward creating a new and improved library service plan, one that will continue to include our increased virtual presence.

The entire Adams County Library staff is looking forward to the reopening of our facilities and providing services to all of you. Be assured, plans are underway to keep both staff and library users safe once Adams County reaches Yellow status!


