Early Literacy Extras:

Parents and caregivers are a child's first and best teachers. Here are some ideas and activities to try this week with your child. These five practices are designed to help your child develop literacy skills, engage your child, and enhance the bonds between you. Storytimes at the Adams County Library support Pennsylvania Early Learning Standards.

This week's theme was: **Picnics**

Read: Watch Miss Emily read *We're Going on a Picnic* by Pat Hutchins on our Youth Services Facebook page or YouTube Channel.

Talk: Talk about what happened in the book. If you were the hungry squirrel what would you take from the basket first? What kind of foods would you bring if you went on a picnic?

Sing: Rhymes to do at Home

Play: Go outside for a picnic. Let your child help pack a basket. Pack a whole meal or even just a snack. Bring a blanket and find a pretty place to sit. Keep an eye out for hungry squirrels!

Write: Make a plate full of paper picnic food. Help your child draw and cut out construction paper shapes – a red triangle for watermelon, a brown square for a sandwich, some purple circles for grapes, etc. Then help your child glue them all to a paper plate.
